1. [redacted] letter [redacted] of 7.5.73 refers to Special Branch report of 14.9.72 in which [redacted] Privacy was mentioned as a member of the Marxist Leninist Workers Association Women's Caucus, and asks for identification particulars of her.

2. The following information has now been received from a reliable source concerning this young woman-

3. [redacted] Privacy (first name unknown) aged about 21 years, paid a visit to London from Canada for some two months in the late summer of 1972 with her parents. During her stay she lived with [redacted] Privacy [redacted] Privacy apparently at home [redacted] Privacy she was either engaged on a teachers training course or was taking some form of further education.

4. Unlike [redacted] Privacy she was a somewhat introverted young woman who was very quiet and took no active part in NIMA discussions. She attended two/three NIMA meetings and a film show organised by Friends of China. However, it is believed this was more out of courtesy to [redacted] Privacy than an indication of her political beliefs."
