1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "The leadership of the International Marxist Group has issued instructions, through branches, for each member to be prepared to commit himself during the coming winter to a long and hard political struggle. IMG see the forthcoming fuel shortage together with industrial action by the power workers and the miners and the obvious resulting discomfort to the 'working class', as an opportunity to become actively involved in political industrial work.

3. Although no particular plans have been formulated, members are being directed to report regularly to the centre of any political activity in their area, particularly those near power stations, mines or storage depots, and to send details of pickets and stoppages immediately to IMG headquarters. Every effort must be made to support the action, together with the selling of 'Red Weekly'. In areas of high activity extra members may be drafted in to assist and members have been told that they must be prepared to travel at short notice to other areas and to commit themselves full-time to the working of the organisation, if at all possible, during the coming winter.
