"The International Socialists - London Regional Committee, is now working with a number of black organisations to organise an anti-police meeting at Brixton Town Hall, Brixton Hill, SW2, on Friday 26 January 1973 commencing at 7.30 pm. This meeting is being held in an effort to combat 'Police Violence' in South London which they feel has culminated in 'the framing of the Oval House Four', who were jailed for two years on a 'mugging' charge.
