THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION HAS BEEN RECEIVED FROM A SECRET AND RELIABLE SOURCE :

Malcolm Kennedy, convicted of murdering a fellow prisoner (Patrick Quinn) at Hammersmith police station, has been given leave to appeal, and his case will be heard at the High Court on 1st July. Kennedy's supporters have been maintaining a regular monthly picket at Hammersmith police station, and they now intend to demonstrate outside the High Court from 09.00 on each day of the appeal hearing.

The Kennedy supporters have proved themselves to be boisterous during their pickets at Hammersmith, but there has not been any disorder. There is no reason to expect their behaviour to change during the appeal, so public order problems are unlikely. The picket will rarely exceed a dozen members at any one time.
