

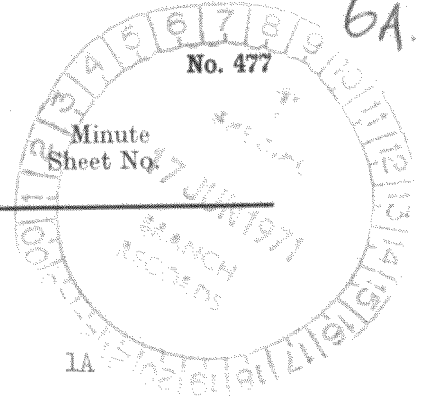

[redacted] Privacy of Nottingham (no further particulars available) has written to several so-called 'Irish political prisoners', stating that he is a member of the Irish National Liberation Solidarity Front, and endeavouring to expound that organisation's Maoist viewpoint. He appears to be a very young man, and to have developed an ardent personal admiration of Edward DAVOREN, to whom he refers as 'our leader'."
