1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "The Organising Committee of the Troops Out Movement met on Friday 31 October 1975 at University of London Union, Malet Street, WC2 from 6.30 pm until 9.30 pm. The entire committee was present and the Chairman was

3. The main topic of discussion was the public meeting to be held by TOM at the time of the Communist Party of Great Britain congress. A leaflet advertising the event had been prepared by Privacy together with a planned structure of the meeting. Gery LAWLESS accepted the leaflet but was opposed to the suggested arrangements for the meeting. LAWLESS said that rank and file members of the Communist Party attracted to the meeting would be completely alienated to TOM by the different lines put by the various left-wing groups within the Movement. He suggested that the meeting be structured to give each Communist Party member present speaking rights and that one contribution be allowed from each of the other left-wing groups represented. LAWLESS's suggestions were passed but not without some opposition from both Privacy and Privacy.

4. LAWLESS suggested that Monday 17 November would be the most suitable date to hold the meeting.

5. The remainder of the evening was taken up with routine business matters, none of which was of particular interest."
