MEMORANDUM

Commander, 'Cps' :

1. The cover identity of Detective Sergeant CLARK, who has been a member of the Special Demonstration Section since July, 1974, and has been 'in the field' since early 1975, has come under scrutiny by London members of 'Big Flame'.
2. There has been not the slightest hint that his true identity is known, but in an unprecedented move he has been confronted with official copies of birth and death certificates in his cover name.
3. The enquirers appear to be confused by other purported facts but in view of this the officer's position in S.D.S. is no longer tenable and I have already made moves to withdraw him from all 'field' activities.
4. Clearly the situation is disturbing but both Superintendent Kneale and I are keeping a very close eye on it.
