1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

"On Tuesday 29th July, 1969, a reception was held at Camden Studios, Camden Street, N.W.1. to celebrate the anniversary of the founding of the Provisional Revolutionary Government of South Vietnam. The reception, attended by about 100 people, many of whom were coloured, was organised by the Britain Vietnam Solidarity Front. The guest of honour was Madame Chi CHON, not Pham Duc THAN as expected. The proceedings commenced at 8.30 p.m. when MANCHANDA welcomed Madame CHON, and then representatives of other revolutionary African movements expressed their solidarity with the Vietnamese people. Two films were shown depicting the Vietnamese people's struggle against 'Imperialist aggression' and the reception closed with the singing of the Internationale at 11.30 p.m."
