The proposed lobby by the Revolutionary Communist ^{Tandem} Group/East London Workers Against Racism (RCT/ELWAR) of the Tower Hamlets Councillors during the course of the Tower Hamlets Council meeting this evening at the Town Hall, Patriots Square E2 failed to materialise.

No ~~fact~~ form of demonstration of this nature took place although the evening was not without incident in that some 80 local tenants/residents chose to heckle from the Public Gallery of the Town Hall whilst the Council debated rent increases and the 'cuts' in general. This action resulted in the Public Gallery being cleared and the demonstrators duly dispersed without further incident.

Local police were in attendance throughout.- There was no disorder other than the above-mentioned minor incident.
