With reference to the Anti-Apartheid demonstration planned for Sunday 25th October 1970, the following information has been received from a reliable but delicate source:-

" It is planned that after the rally in Trafalgar Square, the demonstrators should split into three groups: the first group to march to the offices of the Hawker Siddely Group Ltd., 18 St. James's Square, SW1, carrying a model of a Buccaneer aircraft; the second to go to 10 Downing Street to present a petition, and the third, under the leadership of Peter HAIN, to march to Printing House Square, apparently to visit the 'Times' offices. It appears that the organisers do not approve of the third diversion and are trying to persuade HAIN and his supporters to join one of the other two marches".

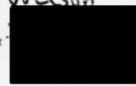
