1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "The Workers Revolutionary Party are organising a march and demonstration for 2nd April 1975, from Hull to Liverpool Merseyside. It will take the same form as that held by the Nigan Builders Action Committee in support of the 'Shrewsbury 2', but this time will supposedly be organised by the Hull Builders Action Committee. This is in line with the WRP plan to set up Action Committees throughout the country.

3. Hull and Liverpool have been chosen as points of departure and arrival so that Arthur SCARGILL, M'rs Union President - Yorkshire, can be 'exposed' for his 'left talk'.

4. Apparently during the 'Shrewsbury 2' march, SCARGILL had said publicly that miners would have supported a call for a General Strike in order to secure the release of the imprisoned man, had they been informed sooner.

5. The HULL/LIVERPOOL march will pass through Yorkshire mining areas and there will be tremendous pressure on SCARGILL to give some support. Nevertheless, he will be denounced as a 'Stalinist betrayer of the working class.'
