1. The following information has been received from a reliable source-

2. The Kingston Branch of the Anarchist Workers Association held a meeting at 16 St Leonards Road, Surbiton, Surrey, on Wednesday 16th April 1975. The meeting commenced at 7.30 pm, concluded at 10.30 pm and was attended by six persons.

3. Privacy assumed the role of chairman and read out the minutes of the previous meetings. He reminded members of three forthcoming events at which the branch should be represented; a) A North London Branch meeting on Thursday 17th April at the 'Mother Red Cap' public house, near Camden Town Underground Station, b) the educational weekend in Leicester on 19th/20th April and c) the Annual General Conference in Leicester on 3rd/4th May. It was agreed that Privacy would attend the North London Branch meeting, Privacy the educational weekend, and that Privacy, Privacy and Jim PICKFORD would be the branch delegates at the Annual General Conference.

4. Privacy spoke about womens equality and mentioned that a leaflet on the subject would be distributed at a Working Womens' Charter meeting in Kingston on 2nd May. Privacy then made a scathing attack on Privacy for his non-attendance at an editorial meeting of Libertarian Struggle as the elected delegate. After some argument on the matter, Privacy apologized for his non-attendance.

5. PICKFORD then gave a brief report of the Wandsworth and Battersea Anti-Fascist meeting that he had attended the previous week, which was of particular interest to Privacy a member of the Kingston Anti-Fascist Committee. Report dated 17.4.75 on sub/69/10/100/1000.
