Privacy papers

The conditions of his employment required him to serve a 'probationary period' of about eight weeks in order that his employers could judge his work ability. This being the case, Privacy gave a 'low profile' account of his political activities in the area, and did not take part in paper sales, open air meetings etc. However, the management learnt of his interest in revolutionary politics and on 2 May 1975 Privacy was sacked. He was told by the management that a certain number of workers were to be made redundant as a result of the present economic climate, but so far, Privacy has been the only worker to lose his job."
