1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. On 1 May 1975 a new department was created within the International Socialists. This department is called the Socialist Worker Information Service (See Socialist Worker No 423, page 6) and takes over from the now defunct International Socialist Information Service (ISIS) which closed down about two years ago after running for about three years.

3. SWIS aims to answer queries from workers regarding their company's investments, shareholders, merger prospects, use of chemicals, and health and safety legislation applicable to their work places. In addition to this service, SWIS has the facilities to search companies at Companies House in order to ascertain names and addresses of directors and their financial interest in the firms.

3. SWIS, like ISIS, is very security-minded, and no enquiries are to be made, discussed or answered by telephone. Instead, all contact with SWIS will be made by letter to Privacy, SWIS, Corbridge Works, Corbridge Crescent, London E2.

4. Privacy is the pseudonym of Privacy of Privacy Privacy. Tel. Privacy, Privacy employed by a firm of stockbrokers in the City, is an active member of Wandsworth IS.

5. Helping Privacy with the smooth running of SWIS is Privacy, another active member of IS.
