1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. On Sunday 14 September 1975, between 5 pm and 7.30 pm at the Luncheon Club, Ledbrooke Grove, W12, the Inner West London District of the International Socialists held a public meeting on the subject of 'Portugal'. Thirty eight persons attended none of whom has been identified.

3. The first speaker, "Pedro", from the Portuguese Workers Co-ordinating Committee, outlined the background to events leading to the coup in Portugal.

4. The second speaker, Andy, a worker from Hammersmith Hospital and a recent visitor to Portugal, stressed the need for workers in this country to ally themselves with those in Portugal. He said that he had helped form a 'Hands off Portugal' Committee within his hospital and hoped that this would lead the way to a national rank and file organisation. He concluded by saying that the workers struggle in Portugal must be brought to the attention of the trade unions in this country and every effort must be made to halt any embargo on trade between the two countries.

5. At the end of the meeting, full support for the Portugal demonstration on 20.9.75 was called for and pledged.
