The following information has been received from a reliable source:

1. An Irish Solidarity Campaign meeting was held from 8pm to 10.45 pm on Thursday 16 February 1972, at the International Marxist Group Centre, 100 Pentonville Road, N1. The meeting was attended by about 15 persons.

2. Much of the meeting was taken up with administrative and minor organizational matters which were of little interest. However, the following points emerged:-

3. In the near future the ISC would be holding an extensive collection around building sites in the London area in support of the IRA. It was advised that this collection should be made as far as possible by those ISC members who were also members of ISM, as in the past, when Irish members and organizations had made collections but all the money had reached its intended destination.

4. The ISC would be working in conjunction with 'Ink' publication in appealing for funds to pay the fines of persons who were 'busted' at the Anti-Internment League demonstration held at Whitehall on Saturday 3 February 1972. (It was mentioned by Bob FURNESS that it would be inadvisable to have Gerry LAYMAN involved in this work as the members of the 'Ink' publication editorial rebuffed him.) The appeal would probably be advertised in 'Ink', 'Irish Citizen' and 'Red Mile.'

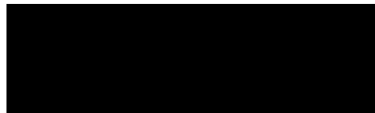
