1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. "On Thursday 1 December 1977 at 8 pm at 29 Grosvenor Avenue, N5, the Anarchy Collective held its regular weekly meeting. Eight persons were present.

3. Almost the entire evening was spent in discussion on the firemen's strike. Privacy  
Privacy produced for examination three posters (1,000 of each) which they had designed (with help from Privacy) for distribution to Fire Stations. Thereafter much talk of what could and should be done to help them, ensued. No firm conclusions were reached, save that Privacy said he would print some "support your local firemen" car and window stickers.

4. After several miscellaneous "news items" (reported separately), the meeting closed at about 11.45 pm."
