SUBJECT

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. On Thursday 11 May 1978 at 8 pm at [Privacy] the Anarchy Collective held its regular weekly meeting. Seven persons were present.

3. Dave MORRIS began the evening by showing those assembled three, four-minute, colour films: two of the rain-soaked Anarchist May Day picnic in Finsbury Park and one of the Anti-Nazi League Demonstration. All present were duly impressed by both his technique and by the cine equipment itself.

4. Thereafter, the majority of the evening was spent in a none too lively discussion of re-allocation of jobs concerned with publishing the Magazine. No definite roles were drawn up, due to the absence of several of the members.

5. The final comment of the evening was made by MORRIS, who announced that he was thinking of organising another Anarchist picnic later in the year, to compensate for the "wash-out" on May Day. Everybody thought that to be an excellent idea, especially in view of the proposed date - Trotsky's 'death day', 20 August. The meeting then closed at 11.30 pm."
