Privacy

1. In their letter [redacted] of 13.10.75 [redacted] refer to a [redacted] Privacy mentioned by Special Branch in January 1974 as an organiser of either the Highbury or Hackney Branch of the Workers Revolutionary Party. They state that they have been unable to identify this man and ask if he might be identical with another [redacted] Privacy mentioned in the "Workers Press" of 7.10.75 as a 16 year old from the Stoke Newington/Hackney North area of London.

2. According to a reliable source the two individuals are not identical, the latter being a current member of Hackney Young Socialists whilst the former left the WRP in mid 1974.

3. Nothing further is known at present of [redacted] Privacy, aged 16, but [redacted] Privacy, subject of Special Branch [redacted] Privacy, came to our notice on several occasions in 1973/4. An officer of the Hackney Branch of the WRP, he was responsible for "Workers Press" sales in the Highbury area. It is understood that he was a student at North London Polytechnic and lived in the Hackney district. Following a dispute with the Party over student policy in the summer of 1974 he resigned to join the Organisation of Revolutionary Anarchists. Nothing has been heard of him since that time.

4. His description has been given as follows:-

Born c. 1953; height 5'6"; dark curly hair; long droopy moustache; tended to wear donkey jacket, sweater and jeans.
