1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "Following the abortive police raid upon the Workers Revolutionary Party Education Centre in Derbyshire, and the resultant political furor, the Party leaders feel that the 'White House' is in little danger of further raids in the present political situation.

3. They are believed, therefore, to be moving the bulk of the party records now stored at their Clapham offices to Derbyshire.

4. Although they do not, at present, fear further open attacks upon the Education Centre they are extremely aware of more clandestine methods of information gathering. To guard against this HEALY is believed to have arranged for a Party electronics expert to install an alarm system for the offices and storage areas in addition to one already fitted.

5. Persons taking part in the two week courses at the Centre are encouraged to organise themselves as 'Workers Militia' to mount a guard on the premises and grounds on a 12 hour shift rota."
