1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. On Thursday 30 October 1975 between 6.30 pm and 9.30 pm at 23 Holden House, Baptist Church Street, SE8, a regular weekly business meeting was held of the South-East London membership of the International Marxist Group. Five persons were present.

3. The main topic of discussion was South East London IMG activity at Thames Polytechnic and in the local branch of the Troops Out Movement. It was revealed that Privacy had been persuaded not to leave the organisation for the time being; this, together with the decision that Privacy should occupy himself with Irish work, meant that three comrades from the area would be intervening regularly in the local TOM - the third being Privacy with regard to work around Thames Polytechnic, it was agreed that a document should be presented by Privacy at the next week's meeting outlining the perspectives in the college for a proposed one-day conference early in December on 'Labour's economic policy'.

4. Of the other members of the area, Privacy had recently been involved in translations for the East-European Commission but now intended to agitate more in his union, NALGO; Privacy who worked in a local GEC factory, was closely involved with the South-East London Institute for Workers Control as well as the IMG Trade Union Sub-Committee; and Privacy the area leader, in addition to working in the teachers' rank and file movement, was endeavouring to join the local Labour Party."
