1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. "On Thursday 5 November 1975 between 6.30 pm and 10 pm at Privacy a regular business meeting was held of the South East London membership of the International Marxist Group. Six persons attended.

3. Once again, the meeting revolved around the question of perspectives for the area. It was agreed that the local branch of the Troops Out Movement should receive regular attention, its meetings being attended by Privacy and one other, both of whom should also attend the IMI London Irish Sub Committee.

4. Privacy who in accordance with the IMI line was to attempt to infiltrate the local Labour Party, woefully reported that he believed that his cover had been blown. Whilst attending a local Labour Party Young Socialist meeting, he was recognised by a Labour Party member to whom he had the week previously sold a copy of 'Red Weekly'. During discussion it was learned that six members of London Branch of the IMI had joined two wards of the Labour Party in the Wandsworth District; these had attracted some twenty other sympathisers, mostly squatters, into the Labour Party, to give the organisation a strong presence in the district."
