1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. On Thursday 18 December 1975 between 7 pm and 10 pm at 23 Holden House, Deptford Church Street, SE8 a regular weekly meeting was held of the SE London IMG, attended by 3 persons.

3. The 'London Notes' for that week and 'Notes to Organisers' contained nothing of interest to Special Branch except the fact that the next London IMG Aggregate was to be held on January 17-18, 1976 venue to be announced later.

4. It transpired that the fund-raising social evening held at 23, Holden House on 13 December 1975 had been a complete failure, resulting in an overall loss to the area organization of £10. In the light of this, it was agreed that those members who had not attended or helped with the function should pay a levy, although in normal circumstances this form of fund-raising is eschewed by the IMG as being devoid of 'political' involvement.

5. The rest of the evening's business was a discussion of the areas perspectives of activity in 1976. The immediate priority is to be the building of support for the Bloody Sunday Commemoration demonstration in February. This, it was decided, would best be effected by greater involvement in SE London Troops Out Movement."
