1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "The organisers of the 'Free George Davis Campaign', following the dismissal of DAVIS's appeal application, have attempted to re-engage the assistance of the Workers Revolutionary Party.

3. The WRP, being mindful of the somewhat adverse publicity caused by previous FGDC antics, has apparently offered only limited support (Workers Press, local meeting platforms, etc) but is believed to be considering the value (to the WRP) of an all out campaign.

4. The main obstacle to the WRP's full assistance is, apparently, the refusal of FGDC organisers to give Gerry HEALY a programme of their forthcoming actions or any guarantee of non-criminal acts (i.e. damage to property etc.)."
