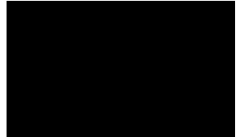

SUBJECT Pavement

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "A meeting was held by the Pavement Collective between 10.30 am and 1 pm on Saturday, 10 January 1976, at [Privacy] the home of [Privacy]. Eight persons were present.

3. The main purpose of the meeting was to discuss articles for the January/February issue of the paper and sales of the previous issue. The only item of particular interest to be discussed was the decision to commence a campaign against [Privacy] a Magistrate at South Western Magistrates' Court. This followed the news that 'Lower Down', the local community magazine, had had an article about the Magistrate censored by the printers, Rye Press.

4. It was agreed that the campaign should commence with an article being written with the assistance of 'Up Against the Law' for publication in the next issue of 'Pavement'. It was also decided that members of the Collective should sit in on cases when [Privac] was on the bench to obtain further items for publication.
