1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. "On Friday 30 January 1976, the Communist Unity Association (Marxist-Leninist) held a study class on Marxism-Leninism at [Privacy] (the house of [Privacy] [Privacy]). The meeting began at 6pm, ended at 10.30pm and was attended by nine persons, several of whom were not members of the Association.

3. [Privacy] introduced the topic to be discussed - an examination of Lenin's lecture on 'The State' - and then led a lively exchange of ideas and interpretations of the work. The discussion appeared to promote such bonhomie that the meeting ended with a decision for talks to be conducted between CUA(N-L) members and non-aligned Marxist-Leninists, including [Privacy] and [Privacy] in pursuance of the present call for the formation of a new revolutionary party.

4. These talks would be arranged at a mutually convenient date but a further study class was fixed for Friday 20 February 1976 at the same venue. The subject matter would be 'Wages, Prices and Capital'."
