SUBJECT

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. A meeting was held by the South London Group of the Anarchist Workers Association on Thursday 13 May 1976 from 7.30 pm until 10.30 pm at [redacted] the home of [redacted] [redacted] was spent most of the evening attempting to prevent [redacted] from interrupting other people speaking, was the chairman and six persons were present.

3. The first topic discussed was the need for premises where the Group could hold meetings and store stationery. [redacted] and [redacted] both seemed to favour renting or leasing a small shop but Jim VICKFORD, Treasurer, said that the Group had insufficient funds to even consider the suggestion. [redacted] then pointed out that the premises could also be used as beddit accommodation for members. [redacted] was eventually delegated to look into the matter, especially with regard to costs.

4. [redacted] reported that while he was taking photographs of the Security Service's building in Curson Street, he was stopped by two Securitor guards who pointed him out to a plain clothes security officer from the premises. He claimed that he had been forcibly detained but had not given the security officer details of himself. When released he was able to take a photograph of the three men as they returned to the building.

5. Nothing else of interest was discussed."
