2. "On Thursday 24th June, 1976, between 7pm and 9pm, at 23 Holden House, Deptford Church Street, SE8, a regular business meeting was held of the South-East London area of the International Marxist Group. Three persons were present.

3. [Redacted] Privacy reported on his intentions to put a motion to Lewisham Trades Council calling for the establishment of an Anti-Racist Sub-Committee. [Redacted] Privacy was urged to raise a similar motion at the Greenwich Trades Council meeting on 1st July, 1976.

4. The only other item of interest to Special Branch was the report of the IMG struggle within the Troops Out Movement to ensure that the Autumn Labour movement delegation to Ireland contacted leading members of the Northern Ireland Labour Party. This was in line with the organisation's orientation toward the Labour Party but was being opposed by the 'Lawless clique' within TOM."
