SUBJECT

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "On Thursday, 12th October 1978, at 8pm, at [Privacy] the home of [Privacy] the Anarchy Collective held its weekly meeting. Five persons were present.

3. The meeting passed uneventfully, the greater part of the time being given over to despatching the latest edition of 'Anarchy' (number 27).

4. Towards the end of the meeting, however, there was a short, general discussion about suitable premises for Anarchy to meet, since the two rooms presently being used at [Privacy] house are, taken as one, scarcely larger than one double bed. Shortage of adequate lighting and heating and an excess of dampness help to emphasise the unsuitability of these rooms, for which the Anarchy Collective is being charged £5 per week by [Privacy].

5. Dave MORRIS provided the only glimmer of hope when he stated that it was possible that he might be able to arrange the use of the basement at Rising Free, 182, Upper Street, N1.

6. With an invitation from Chris BROAD to meet next time at his new home [Privacy] the meeting came to a close at about 10.40pm."
