1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. There was a meeting at the Roebuck Public House on Tuesday, 22 June at 6.30 pm, held under the auspices of the Socialist Worker. Of the 40 who attended, most were actual members of IS. The two speakers were [redacted] who had recently returned from Portugal and [redacted] both are members of the IS International Committee. [redacted] gave a general review of the left movement in Portugal and [redacted] the same for Spain, Italy and Greece. It was stated that there was massive unemployment in Portugal - about 1 million - and at one recent meeting in Oporto some 70,000 people attended to demand some government action to reduce these figures. IS has prepared a digest of English legislation regarding safety in factories and this has been translated into Portuguese for distribution by their FOD. With regards to Southern Europe it was stated that the continued political crisis was caused by the USA supported by British and West German aid. There was a bookstall run by a member called [redacted]
