1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

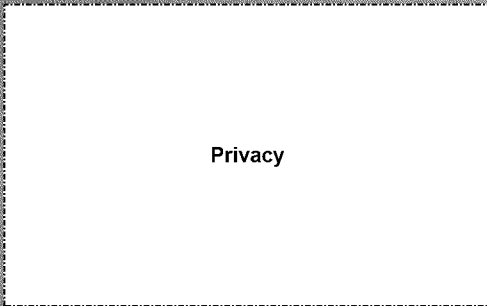
2. "Several anarchists met between 8.20pm and 10.20pm at the Rising Free Bookshop at 182, Upper Street, E1 on Tuesday 30 August 1977. The intention of the meeting, which was attended by about twelve people, was to try and form a network of working anarchists in London and provide an opportunity for regular meetings and discussions.

3. Most of the talking was done by Dave MORRIS, with occasional comments from others present, and much of the meeting was spent in thrashing out exactly what kind of group could be formed. After a great deal of debate, it was finally decided that it should initially take the shape of the now defunct Anarchist Industrial Network, ie a contact list of working anarchists and a regular bulletin; in this way it was hoped that more and more uncommitted anarchists in employment would join together to form a genuinely active anarchist group.

4. The next meeting was arranged for Tuesday, 27 September, 1977, at the same venue."
