SUBJECT

Privacy

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. Privacy a leading member of the Building Workers Rank and File group, has recently taken an interest in the sewerage workers' dispute at Finsbury Park Road, N4. At a meeting of building workers held at the Co-Op Hall, Seven Sisters Road, N7, at 6 pm on Tuesday, 4 October 1977; he promised to try and raise more support for them.

3. In September this year, Privacy was dismissed from his job on a Camden Council building site for unsatisfactory work. He is now organising the subsequent unofficial strike by other Camden building workers.

4. Privacy still resides at Privacy the address of his ex-wife Privacy. However, Privacy the District Convener of the North London District of the SWP, is not happy with this arrangement and is trying to get Privacy to move.

5. Although no longer a member of the Socialist Workers Party, Privacy still takes an interest in the former Organisation's affairs.

6. Privacy has been mentioned on two previous occasions concerning her involvement with the Socialist Workers Party.
