1. The following information has been received from a reliable source, which needs to be protected:-

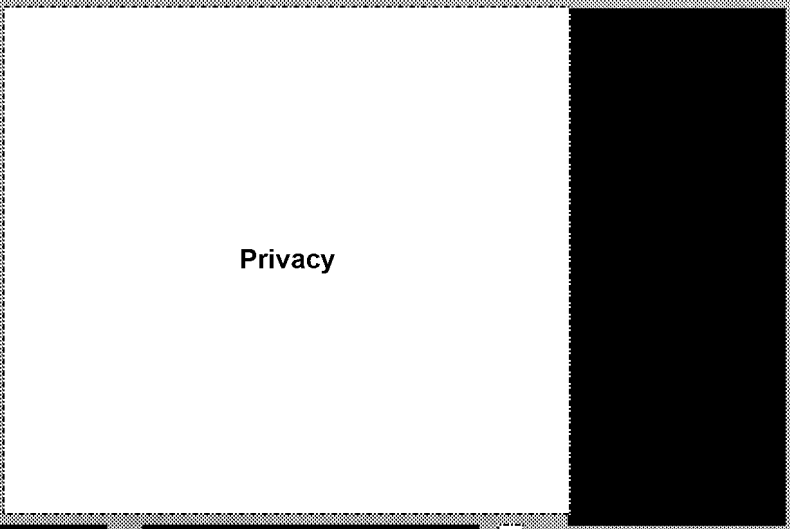
2. "A private meeting of anarchist activists and Black Aid supporters took place at the London School of Economics on Monday, 10 July, 1978, at about 7.30 pm. About 9 persons were present.

3. The main topic of discussion was the group's failure to gain entry to the meeting of the New Communist Party at Conway Hall, Red Lion Square, W1 on Friday 7 July 1978 and cause disruption (as proposed at the previous LSA meeting).

4. Before discussion became too involved, however, a porter at the LSE demanded that comrades leave and they then re-assembled in the College bar.

5. Because this was the second occasion the meeting had been disrupted by a school porter, it was decided that the group would hold the next meeting (on Monday 17 July) at the George IV Public House nearby."
