"On Monday, 3 July 1978, at 7.30pm, at the Organising Committee of the Kilburn and Queens Park Branch of the Anti-Nazi League (ANL) held a meeting to arrange details for the 'Multi-Racial Festival' scheduled to take place on 23 July, 1978, at Kilburn Grange Park (see leaflet attached). About 10 persons were present.

3. acting as chairman, began with a discussion on publicity for the Festival. A limit of £30 for leaflets and posters was decided upon and was deputed to arrange the printing.

4. Advertisements in local papers were also planned and a long list of live entertainments was drawn up. It was also decided that all ANL contacts in the area should be visited as soon as possible."
