"On Friday 27th November 1970, at Camden Studios, Camden Street, NW1, the Revolutionary Marxist-Leninist League held a farewell party for Privacy and Linh QUI, representatives in this country of the Democratic Republic of Vietnam, who were returning to Hanoi on Monday 30 November 1970.

The function, which had been organised by Abhimanyu MANCHANDA, general secretary of the R.M.L.L., commenced at 7.30 pm and ended at 11 pm. Although several hundred invitations had been distributed amongst various left-wing organisations only 40 persons were present. Of those only about eight were from groups other than the R.M.L.L., British Vietnam Solidarity Front and the Women's Liberation Front. MANCHANDA openly expressed disappointment at the small attendance.

At the end of the party MANCHANDA made a short speech on behalf of the hosts and gave Privacy a suitably inscribed banner. Diane LANGFORD and Privacy then spoke briefly for the W.L.F. and B.V.S.P., respectively, after which representatives from Friends of Korea, Pan African Congress and South West Africa National Union made short remarks. Following this, Gajawan BIJUR spoke and presented a bouquet of flowers. Finally, a young American named Privacy presented a number of books of English folk-songs.
