The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

On Sunday, 29 November 1970, at Camden Studios, Camden Street, NW1, a public meeting was held under the auspices of the Revolutionary Marxist Leninist League and Friends of China to celebrate the 26th Anniversary of Socialist Albania. The meeting which commenced at 7 pm and finished at 10 pm, was attended by 18 persons. Abhimanyu MANCHANDA was the chairman and the only speaker.

MANCHANDA opened with a detailed account of the Albanian Revolution and what had been achieved by that country since that time. He then invited questions and discussion on the subject. This developed into a heated argument between MANCHANDA, Privacy and a man who was evidently from the C.P.G.B. The theme of the discussion was quickly changed from Albania to the differences between Russian and Chinese Communism and American Imperialism. Towards the end of the meeting MANCHANDA attempted to silence Privacy but he Privacy insisted on continuing the argument. Privacy then intervened and announced that the meeting would have to close as time had run out.
