2. On Friday, 17 March, 1978, between 8 pm and 10 pm, at Woolwich Public Hall, Market Street, SE18, the Greenwich Campaign Against Racism and Fascism held its inaugural meeting. About 120 persons were present.

3. Proceedings were chaired by [redacted] who introduced a local clergyman as the guest speaker (he had agreed to stand in for [redacted] who was apparently indisposed). The clergyman described the Campaign's proposals for action, including the need for leafletting in the area. At this point a number of clip-boards were circulated, so that volunteers willing to undertake leafletting work could provide their names and addresses.

4. The chairman then invited those present to address the meeting with any of their own, or their organisation's, views on the topic. The response was good and a dozen or so of the audience took the opportunity to speak.

After this, the proposed structure of the Campaign's committee was discussed and it was decided that four persons should be elected onto it, if possible from each of five groups, namely: political, trades unions, ethnic, religious and 'independents'. Accordingly, a series of votes took place and four individuals were elected. Since there then remained no further business to complete, a collection was taken and the meeting brought to a close."

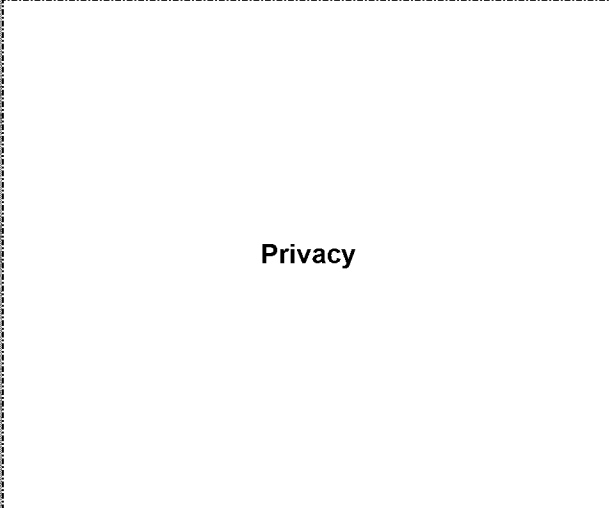

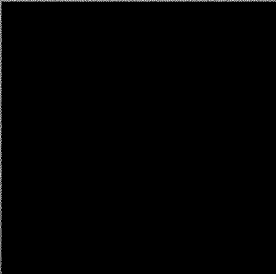
