1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "On Monday 3rd February 1975 from 8 pm to 10 15 pm at Portway School, off the Portway, West Ham, E 15, the first in a series of four lectures on Marxism was held under the auspices of the Workers Revolutionary Party. about 100 persons attended.

3. The meeting was chaired by **Privacy** who gave a brief introductory speech about the nature of the WRP before introducing Gerry HEALY, the General Secretary of the organisation.

4. HEALY's lecture dealt at length with the origins and development of philosophy and was presumably intended to form a basis for the subsequent examination of Marxism.

5. Following the lecture, **Privacy** made an appeal for funds which realised £6.25."
