1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. "Privacy, formerly of Wildcat, recently attended the National Conference of the Anarchist Workers Association as an observer. He stated that he was a delegate from the recently formed 'Central London Anarchist Group' of which nothing had been heard previously. From what he said, it is believed that this group meets at Peoples News Service in Kings Cross. He stated that his reason for attending the National Conference was to ascertain the possibility of the AWA joining the 'Anarchist Federation of Britain', which had held a conference that weekend (14/15 February) in Warwick. The AWA has no intention of joining any such organisation but would send representatives to its meetings for the purpose of causing disruption."
