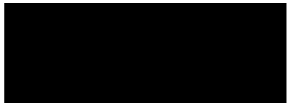

"On Wednesday, 21 April 1976 between 8 pm and 10 pm, at Charlton House, SE6, a meeting was held under the auspices of the International Marxist Group to build support for a South-East London Branch of the National Co-ordinating Committee Against Cuts in the National Health Service. Ten persons were present.
