1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "On Saturday 28th June, 1975, from 9 pm to 11 pm, a meeting of the National Front was held at [redacted] Privacy

3. The meeting was attended by nine persons and the only speaker, a man aged about 30 years, apparently from the NF HQ at Croydon, was pointedly addressed as 'Privacy'. This is almost certainly a pseudonym.

4. He said that in the coming year efforts were to be made to mount small scale demonstrations on every occasion that the NF was denied 'democratic access to public platforms and meeting places'. It appeared in fact that he was intending to organise such actions before approaching certain bodies which would undoubtedly refuse him such access.

5. The remainder of the meeting was concerned with the organisation of the regular NF bill posting and leafletting round and nothing further of interest to Special Branch was mentioned."
