1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "On Wednesday 2 July 1975 between 8 pm and 10 pm in a private room at the 'Queens Arms' public house, Barrage Road, SE18, a regular weekly aggregate meeting was held of the South-East London members of the International Marxist Group. Once again, this was a poorly attended affair with only four members present and as a result little was discussed.

3. It was agreed that the district would support the picket organised by the South-East London Troops Out Movement outside Woolwich Barracks on Friday 11th.

4. Further to the previous week's discussion on the IMG's intervention in the local Labour Party, Privacy felt that he and Privacy should undertake this work; it was their initial intention to find a ward that was left-wing orientated and obtain an accommodation address in that area.

5. An invitation had been received from the Local Communist Party for the IMG to participate in a debate to be held late in July centred mainly on the nature of Soviet Communism; this was accepted and a short educational programme drawn up to enable members to acquit themselves well at this event."
