SUBJECT

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. Privacy an active supporter of the Communist Party of England (M-L), and a member of the Indian Workers Movement and the East London Peoples Front, is now believed to be living with Privacy at the latter's home at Privacy

Reference to Papers

3. Privacy arrested in September 1977 at the ELPF Ilford to Barking march on a charge of assault, failed to attend the court hearing of his case at Barking in April of this year and a warrant for his arrest was subsequently issued. He afterwards disappeared from London political life for several weeks and the rumour and speculation of the time that he was in Canada now appears to have been true (although secrecy still surrounds his 'disappearance'). It is likely, too, that he represented the CPE(M-L) at the international Marxist-Leninist rally, held in Canada in May.

4. He is adopting a low key role at the moment, devoting most of his time to Indian Workers Movement matters. To delay his inevitable arrest, he has changed his name to Privacy and constantly urges his comrades to refer to him publicly by this name.

5. He now has short-cropped hair and sports a short, trimmed beard. He usually wears light coloured jumpers, jeans and a large blue anorak."

6. Privacy is the subject of EP Privacy

7. The Communist Party of England (M-L), the Indian Workers Movement and the East London Peoples Front are dealt with on 400/77/189, 400/75/34 and 400/77/250 respectively.
