4. The main point of discussion was the failure of the Anti-Nazi League to give sufficient notice of their counter-demonstration to the National Front parade held on Remembrance Sunday. It was claimed that this was the reason for the low turn-out of both ANL and SWP supporters for the event. Before the meeting was brought to a close, therefore, a resolution of criticism, addressed to the ANL Central Committee, was drafted by [redacted].
