1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "On Monday 4th December 1978, at 8 p.m., at the Prince Albert Public House, Watling Street, Bexleyheath, the Bexley Branch of the Anti Nazi League held a business meeting. Some ten persons attended.

3. The meeting was chaired by [Privacy], who introduced two main topics. Firstly, the necessity for distributing ANL leaflets in the Bexley area and secondly a planned Christmas social for fund raising. No firm date was fixed for the latter and, with regard to the leaflets, it was felt that the predominance of Plumstead SWP members present would do little to ensure their distribution in the Bexley area. [Privacy] then drew attention to the fact that it was essential that ANL contacts be visited.

4. However, the meeting was poorly attended and quickly 'degenerated' into an all SWP affair. After the usual collection, proceedings were brought to a close at about 9.45 p.m.
