SUBJECT

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. On Monday, 22nd January 1979, at Spa, the North-west London District Committee of the Socialist Workers Party held one of its fortnightly meetings. Some seven persons were present.

3. The meeting, which was the first of the newly-elected District Committee, was chaired by [redacted] [redacted] [redacted] [redacted] asked that all the branches within the District compile a list of council depots and factories in their area, so that these could be regularly leafleted.

4. Paul GAY, nominated as District 'Socialist Worker' newspaper organiser, was requested to hold regular meetings with branch organisers to find out where and how many papers were being sold each week.

5. Finally, [redacted] and [redacted] disclosed that they had drafted a bulletin to assist the lorry drivers (at that time still in dispute) and that this would be printed and distributed throughout the District.
