2. "On Thursday 21 February 1980 the Workers Socialist League had booked Lyndhurst Hall, Warden Road, NW5, from 7 pm to 11 pm for the purpose of holding a public meeting. Although contingents from the Spartacist League (SL), Leninist Faction (LP) and the Revolutionary Labour League (RLL) attended, no representatives of the WSL appeared; therefore at 8.30 pm it was presumed by the eight people present that no meeting would in fact be held."
