1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. On Saturday 21st May 1980, an anti-nuclear demonstration under the auspices of The Dungeness Action Alliance, will take place at Dungeness, Kent, to show opposition against the Government's proposal to construct a pressurised water reactor at Dungeness Power Station.

3. The participants will assemble at the Pilot P.H., Lydd at 2pm followed by a march to a rally at Dungeness which will include speeches and a sponsored balloon release to illustrate the diffusion of any future accidental radioactive spillage.

4. A bicycle rally from London to Lydd, leaving Bromley South Station between 6am - 8am has also been arranged to coincide with the demonstration.

5. The demonstration has been widely publicised amongst 'anti-nuke' groups and a large turn-out is anticipated. Students Against Nuclear Energy (SANE) have voiced an expectancy of around three thousand persons attending.

6. The event is to be well marshalled and there is no evidence to suggest that the event will be anything other than peaceful.
