SUBJECT

Reference to Papers

1. This report deals with information shown on Special Branch Form B/1, dated 26th June, 1980, which suggests that one [Privacy] a member of the Revolutionary Communist Tendency and active in that organisation's 'Smash the Prevention of Terrorism Campaign', is identical with [Privacy] who is the subject of the marginally quoted references.

2. At this juncture it is apparent that the two persons mentioned are, in fact, NOT identical.

3. [Privacy] the subject of RF [Privacy] has been a member of the Tottenham Branch of the Socialist Workers Party since the spring of 1977 and, in addition to this, has also played an active part in the local Women's Voice Group. These two political groups would not render her political activities or beliefs compatible with those expressed by the members of the Revolutionary Communist Tendency.

4. Since first coming to notice in June, 1977, she has lived at [Privacy] in a two-roomed flat on the first floor. Originally she was sharing this accommodation with [Privacy] (also a member of the SWP), but after a short while they split up and [Privacy] moved to an empty flat in the basement.

5. Early in 1978, she formed a relationship with [Privacy] the National Treasurer of Flame and from that time until the autumn of 1979 the couple lived together at her flat. However, this relationship foundered when [Privacy] felt that his political activities were interfering with their relationship and he moved to [Privacy] a house owned by the local council and rented by a housing co-operative.

6. Since that time she has been 'unattached', until recently when she formed a relationship with a bus conductor on the [Privacy] bus route' called [Privacy] (a black-belt Karate exponent) and it is likely that this liaison will blossom although the two characters prefer at present to maintain their independence. However, she still lives at [Privacy] [Privacy] [Privacy] and in the last week has intimated that she wishes to fall pregnant again and for this purpose had ceased to 'take the pill' on a regular basis. She is, however, not quite sure at the present as to who will sire this latest socialist offspring.

7. In the autumn of 1979 she completed a six months Government training course as a centre lathe turner and is now employed in this capacity by [Privacy] [Privacy] [Privacy]

8. With regard to her recent political involvement, it can be said that in the last eighteen months she has tended to 'drop out' whilst undergoing her training and settling in to her new job, relying for pleasure mainly on the twin evils of alcohol and cannabis resin rather than the mental involvement of revolutionary socialist politics. Indeed, it is only in the last three months that she has regained her enthusiasm for active political work and in the last month or two has still only attended the odd meeting.

9. Whilst not actively engaged on a firm political basis, she had still retained close links on a social basis with her many friends in the Tottenham Socialist Workers Party and Haringey/Tottenham Women's Voice and it can be stated quite strongly that her current political bias would not include an interest in Irish orientated groups, let alone the ideals of the Revolutionary Communist Tendency, as her main interest, culturally, politically and personally is with the black races and persons of similar ethnic origins.

10. One additional factor, which is extremely relevant, is the fact that for the last eighteen months she has reverted to using her maiden name of [Privacy] which is in line with current feminist principles.
