SUBJECT

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. [Privacy] the full-time Socialist Workers Party Organiser for the [Privacy] Districts, and [Privacy] a member of Women's Voice, [Privacy] have ceased living together at [Privacy]

3. The decision to separate was taken by [Privacy] who has since moved out of the premises with a view to developing an individual style of living, having apparently tired of maintained a 'claustrophobic dual relationship'.

4. However, the split appears to have been undertaken with no ill feeling and both persons remain good friends in political and social circles. It is conceivable that continual pressure upon [Privacy] to join the Socialist Workers Party and not remain merely a member of Women's Voice may have been instrumental in the breakdown of their relationship.

5. Despite current outward appearances, the loss of his flat-mate has had a deep traumatic effect on [Privacy] and he intends to take a three-week holiday from his duties with the Socialist Workers Party and has intimated that he may, on his return, give up full-time Party work and seek a 'normal' job."
